



## Hole by Hole

### Hole 1 - Gables - Par 4, 323m

Don't be afraid of the wall behind the green on approach; the front bunker awaits if you're tentative.

### Hole 2 - Park - Par 3, 163m

The front bunker gives the illusion of shortening the hole. The green is further back than it seems.

### Hole 3 - Slemish - Par 5, 448m

If you can't carry the two deep front bunkers, don't flirt with running between them.

### Hole 4 - Corner - Par 3, 138m

The wind will play an important part in club decision here.

### Hole 5 - Kew Gardens - Par 4, 350m

Tee shot position vital. Long green; take note of flag position for right club selection.

### Hole 6 - Race View - Par 4, 354m

Favour right side of fairway from the tee. Slightly raised green.

### Hole 7 - Recess - Par 3, 103m

Short hole, big green, looks easy. Beware of complacency.

### Hole 8 - Crebilly - Par 4, 345m

Tee-box faces slightly left, adjust aim for this – there's more room on the right than there appears. Note this is a two-tier green.

### Hole 9 - Larches - Par 5, 449m

Birdie chance. Bunkers on the left side await second shots.

## Hole by Hole cont.

### Hole 10 - Devenagh - Par 3, 187m

There's a bail out left of the green. The wind direction is vital in club choice.

### Hole 11 - Boundary - Par 4, 406m

Fine golf hole. Tend left off the tee. If someone offers you a four, take it!

### Hole 12 - The Drain - Par 4, 381m

Anything right from the tee brings trees into play on blind second shot.

### Hole 13 - Hatchery - Par 4, 271m

Keep a touch left of centre from the tee. Receptive green for attacking the pin.

### Hole 14 - The Doubles - Par 3, 200m

Distance deceptive from the tee-box. Slight dip on fairway gives appearance of playing shorter than its length.

### Hole 15 - Braid Valley - Par 4, 360m

Tee-box aims you a little more to the left than necessary. More room on the right than visible.

### Hole 16 - The Firs - Par 3, 188m

Terrific par 3 for the gents. Well guarded right and left with a raised green.

### Hole 17 - Stacks - Par 4, 333m

Don't be tempted to cut the corner. Play to the angle of the fairway leaving medium to short iron approach.

### Hole 18 - The Road - Par 4, 300m

Inviting final hole. Play enough club on second shot to carry front greenside bunkers which eat well into the green.
